Notice on the Prevention of Infection with a Novel Coronavirus

Cases of pneumonia caused by a novel coronavirus have recently been reported in the city of Wuhan, Hubei province, the People's Republic of China. As a precautionary measure, travellers to China are advised to follow the instructions below. This will help early detect such pneumonia cases and prevent the spread of diseases.

|| What should I do to avoid infection?

 \cdot Keep out of any contact with poultry or wild animals and never visit a market.

• Keep out of any contact with people who are unwell or showing respiratory symptoms such as fevers and coughs.

 \cdot Take personal protective actions such as washing hands, covering your coughs or sneezes with an upper sleeve, and wearing a mask.

|| What should I do after returning to Korea?

- If you develop a fever and respiratory symptoms (e.g. coughs, sore throat, difficulty in breathing, etc.) within 14 days of your returning to Korea, please call the KCDC Call Center at 1339.
- If you develop any respiratory symptoms, wear a mask (when you go outside or visit a medical clinic or a hospital).
- \cdot Wash your hands with running water for more than 30 seconds.
- When you visit a medical clinic or a hospital, tell your doctor your overseas travel history (history of visiting Wuhan within 14 days of your development of respiratory symptoms, including your stopovers).
